Professional Phase Student Application Requirements and Procedures

Dear SIUC Pre-ATEP Student,

Thanks for all your hard work so far this year. As your Pre-ATEP experience is drawing to a close, the SIUC ATEP faculty and staff are excited for the coming year and sincerely hope you will consider applying for the Professional Phase of the program. In order to be considered for Professional Phase Student admission to the SIUC Athletic Training Education Program, please complete and submit all of the following prescribed materials. Professional Phase Student admission requires the following:

1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50
2. Grade of 'B' or better (or current enrollment) in KIN 225 and KIN 226
3. 75 hours of documented directed observation, at least half of which accrued on the SIUC campus
4. Grade of 'C' or better (or current enrollment) in KIN 300 (Musculoskeletal Anatomy), PHSL 201/208 (Human Physiology and Physiology Lab), and CHEM 140a or equivalent

Once completed, return all requested information to the SIUC Athletic Training Education Program Director. This information includes:

1. Professional résumé and cover letter
2. Athletic Training Education Program Professional Phase Student Application
3. Transcripts of all college coursework to date
4. Documentation demonstrating completion of at least 75 hours of directed athletic training observation
5. Brief (2-4 page) essay describing personal and professional goals in athletic training
6. Three (3) completed Standardized Applicant Recommendations using the forms provided. Forms must be originals in sealed and signed envelopes from one faculty member, one Certified Athletic Trainer, and one personal reference. The top portion of the form should be filled-out by you & the authorization waiver section should be checked and signed. (Note: these may be mailed separately by your references)
7. Signed and dated Athletic Training Technical Standards for Admission form
8. Completed physician physical examination form
9. Copy of current First Aid & CPR cards
10. Proof of Hepatitis B vaccination OR signed Hepatitis B vaccination waiver form

11. Proof of Tuberculosis (PPD) vaccination

In addition to the above listed materials, admission will also be dependent upon other criteria, as well. Student performance evaluations completed during the Pre-ATEP by the Approved Clinical Instructional staff will be used and each applicant will also be required to complete a full formal interview with the admissions panel.

Deadline for Application

The deadline for applications is WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 12. Students will be notified concerning their application status the week of December 1. Should a student not gain acceptance at that time, applicants may reapply for the spring admissions round; however, there is no guarantee of acceptance.

Notification of Status

Following the application deadline, the admissions panel will carefully review each complete application packet. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

A maximum of three students will be identified as alternates and will be eligible for Professional Phase Student admission immediately should a position become vacated. Otherwise, students will be required to apply for admission the following semester.
